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

On the 4th of August in what was already a challenging year, the city of Beirut was devastated by a shattering explosion, the effects of which shook the world. Christie's immediately felt a deep sense of responsibility to help rebuild a city so rich in culture. We Are All Beirut is a charity auction dedicated to helping the arts community by offering a unique selection of works seeking to unite the regional arts through this noble cause.

Sale proceeds will benefit Arab Fund Arts & Culture (AFAC) a trusted NGO, to directly assist the arts in Beirut, with additional proceeds given to the Red Cross from a section of the sale, generously sourced by Arthaus Beirut.

AFAC will be pooling the resources towards redistributing financial support across all artistic fields, specifically targeting the arts scene. Institutions such as the Sursock Museum, studios and local galleries that suffered extensive damage will receive support, both in terms of repairing structural damages and via rehabilitation programmes that AFAC launched after the explosion.

We have taken great hope from the solidarity shown in supporting Beirut's arts community when we announced the charity auction. The response from the world's cultural communities has been humbling, reinforcing that the arts not only brings people together, but is also critical in defending a nation's identity


